£75m retail scheme for city progressing well

DEMOLITION work is progressing on a site which will house a £75 million retail scheme in Worcester.

We previously reported in your *Worcester News* how the work is already under way on the former

Vinegar Works site at Lowesmoor. The project will ultimately bring supermarket giant Asda to the city, as well as up to 13 other new shops, 10 apartments, office space, a restaurant and a multi-storey car park.

A spokesman for Carillion Richardson, the development firm behind the scheme, said contractual discussions are now under way with construction companies.

He said he hoped they

would be resolved in January with a view to building starting later in the year.

But before that happens the Territorial Army, which is currently based in Silver Street, will have to

be moved into new administration and training facilities in the grade two-listed filling shed building on the Lowesmoor site, while a new garaging premises will also be provided in Midland Road.
